



### USE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY BYLAW NO. 720, 2023

All applicants wishing to occupy public property must provide proof of two (2) million third party liability insurance listing the Village of Nakusp as an additionally insured.

#### Business in C1 and LD1 Zones & Sandwich Board Signs:

Allowed one of the following to occupy a portion of the sidewalk:

- ◆ Placement of not more than two (2) chairs with one (1) table;
- ◆ Placement of not more than two (2) chairs;
- ◆ Placement of one or more racks, or merchandise of up to 3 meters in length; or,
- ◆ A display stand or table, not longer than 3 meters in length, for the display of goods for sale.

Each business is permitted one (1) sandwich Board Signs to be placed directly in front of the business it is advertising for.

*Please do not obstruct cross walks, or place items in flower beds.*

A Licence of Occupation agreement is required for the following types of Public Property Uses, associated fees can be found in the Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 693, 2020.

#### Mobile Food Cart:

Two (2) seasonal food carts are allowed to operate in the municipality each operating season (May 1 - October 31st). A list of requirements to operate a Food Cart can be found in the bylaw.

### USE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY BYLAW NO. 720, 2023 continued.

#### Food Truck:

Three (3) seasonal food trucks are allowed to operate in the municipality each season (operating season May 1 - October 31).

- ◆ Up to two (2) at the Public Beach; and,
- ◆ No more than one (1) at the Nakusp Hot Springs.

A fourth food truck will be permitted to operate at Council's discretion. Additional food trucks will be permitted to operate during special events taking place on public property.

A list of requirements to operate a Food Truck can be found in the bylaw.

#### Seasonal Patio Expansion:

Seasonal patio expansions are permitted on the street adjacent to the business, not on Broadway Street.

Any patio expansion that is constructed above grade must pass an inspection by the building inspector before being used each season.

Operating season is May 1st to October 15th each year.

#### Not for Profit Organization Use of Park Area:

A not for profit may use the park area free of charge provided:

- ◆ Event or Programming is for the community; and,
- ◆ Event or Programming is free of charge to the community to attend.

A rental agreement and damage deposit is required.

### WATER CONSERVATION - May 1st Each Year

Water Conservation Stage 1 is in effect, which means:

Even numbered premises water on even days, odd numbered premises water on odd days.

Between 6:00 AM and 9:00 AM, as well as, 8:00 PM and 11:00 PM for hose supplied sprinklers; or,

Between Midnight (12:00 AM) and 6:00 AM for underground automated sprinkler systems.

At any address, on any day, a person is also permitted to use water for the following:

Drip or micro sprinkler irrigation, or hand watering of flower or vegetable gardens, decorative planters, shrubs or trees. Use of hose to wash boats, motor vehicles or driveways only if hose is equipped with an automatic shut off device. Watering of public sports fields, school yards or public parks and cemeteries. Filling and maintaining of private pools, spas, hot tubs, ponds and bird baths. Water for children's play and commercial car washes.

### 2023 PROPERTY TAXES

Property tax notices will be mailed out in mid May. If you have not received your tax notice by June, please contact the Village office to obtain a copy. Taxes are due July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023. A 10% penalty will be applied to all outstanding amounts after the due date. Don't forget to apply for your Homeowner Grant through the province before the due date. Information regarding how to apply is included on your tax notice.

### ZONING BYLAW

Staff have been working on the Zoning bylaw based off the feedback from the public and Council's direction. A public hearing will be held at a separate meeting after the Zoning bylaw has received first reading.

### PUBLIC WORKS

#### Street Sweeping

We have the street sweeping contractor coming this week, as soon as we have confirmed the schedule we will announce it on [www.nakusp.com](http://www.nakusp.com) and the Voyent Alert app. When street sweeping begins residents are asked to not park on or have anything obstructing the pavement of Village residential streets. Commercial streets will be swept early in the morning so please do not park overnight in commercial zones during the spring sweep.

#### Appreciation

Thank you to residents for being patient with road and sidewalk closures, Works crews appreciate your driving around worksites slowly and giving them lots of room while they repair and replace infrastructure. More sidewalk projects will be announced when crews are ready to start, please keep an eye on our website and on Voyent Alert.

#### Water

The annual water main flushing and hydrant maintenance will be started earlier this year in May and will progress through August. If your water is discolored or cloudy please run the cold water tap until clear. This flushing is done to remove sediments from the water mains which maintains our high water quality.

If you are experiencing water quality issues such as a strong chlorine odor, discoloration or anything else it is important to contact Village of Nakusp Public Works immediately so that serious issues can be tracked and investigated while they are occurring.
