Memorial Trees

All memorial trees at minimum, are to be hardy in Zone 6 of the Canadian Plant Hardiness Zones (Nakusp is Zone 7A). Local or regional nurseries can provide suitable caliper specimens.

Fruit and berry producing trees will not be accepted due to being bear attractants and for maintenance concerns. Specific trees and/or species that are not acceptable are:

Black Locust, Robinia pseudoacacia Cherry Laurel, Prunus laurocerasus European Hawthorn, Crataegus monogyna European Mountain Ash, Sorbus aucuparia Horse Chestnut, Aesculus hippocastanum Siberian Elm, Ulmus pumila Tree of Heaven, Ailanthus altissima

Memorial Benches/Picnic Tables

The Nakusp Waterfront Walk, Nakusp Beach, and the Community Park are not available for benches or picnic tables these areas have a full complement of park furniture. Memorial bench locations will be considered at the athletic fields and on Village trails other than the Waterfront Walk.

Downtown Memorial/Sponsorship Benches

Memorial/Sponsorship benches on Broadway Street from 6th Avenue NW to Nelson Ave NW will only be available as specified in the landscape drawings of the Downtown Revitalization
